## **Policy**

- Defn: Guiding principle leading to course of action or specific program pursued by governments
  - ✓ Rationale for what we do (basis for action)
- Programs (or policy tools) implement policy
- Examples:
  - ✓ Policy Reduce global warming
  - ✓ Programs Cap and trade program

## **Agricultural and Food policy**

- Principles that guide government programs that influence:
  - ✓ Production
  - Resources used and how they are used
  - ✓ Domestic and international markets
  - ✓ Food consumption
  - Conditions under which rural people live













#### China's GDP growth, change from the same period a year earlier






#### Wild Swings in Food Prices

"Surging Demand for Farm Operating Loans Hints at Growing Risk" - The KC Fed recently reported, "Short-term operating loan volumes continued to surge in the second quarter of 2015, highlighting a growing risk in U.S. agriculture amid a period of lower farm income." "According to the USDA, crop cash receipts have declined 22 percent since 2012, but costs associated with manufactured inputs, seeds and rent declined just 1 percent in the same period. Amid growing disparity between crop revenue and input costs, the ratio of current operating loan volumes to net farm income grew significantly in 2015." As you can see form the graphic below, "operating loan" volumes surged 25 percent from a year ago. This is some good information presented by The Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City, specifically Nathan Kauffman, Assistant Vice President and Omaha Branch Executive, Cortney Cowley, Economist and John McCoy, Intern. Chart 2: Current Operating Loan Volume





#### by Company and Nation




